The Seminar is designed to enable its participants to become better leaders by understanding the goals that motivate us and how our values both coincide and conflict with those of others.

METHODOLOGY

The seminar will call for extensive participation and will require prior preparation. Each participant will receive a set of readings (both Modern and Classical) in advance. These readings form the basis for the exploration. Coupled with each participant’s experiences and perspectives, they form a challenging brew to explore deeply-held opinions and behaviour. The facilitators will moderate rather than lecture, allowing the richness in the room come out.

BRIEF PROFILE OF MODERATORS

JAMES ABRAHAM is the founder and director of SolarArise, which will own and operate one of the largest portfolios of solar-power plants in India. Prior to this, he was the Managing Director of SunBorne Energy, which focuses on making solar energy as low-cost as other sources of power in India. James and the team led the



development of solar policy in India and launched the largest public-private partnership in solar R&D with the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy. James is currently a member of the Confederation of Indian Industry's Renewable Energy Council, the US-India Track 2 Dialogue on Climate Change, and serves on several boards. Prior to SunBorne, James was a senior partner at The Boston Consulting Group in India. He started his career with BCG in Toronto before moving to India in 1998, and then founded BCG's New Delhi office. James has a degree in electrical engineering from the University of Waterloo, an MBA (Baker Scholar) from the Wharton School, and an MA (international relations) from the Johns Hopkins School for Advanced International Studies. He is a Fellow of the third class of the India Leadership Initiative and a member of the Aspen Global Leadership Network.

GOVINDRAJ ETHIRAJ is a television & print journalist and Founder-Editor of Indiaspend, a public interest journalism

effort which utilizes open data to analyze a range of issues. Recently Indiaspend won second place at the BMW Foundation Responsible Leaders Awards 2014. He is also a Co-Founder at Ping Digital Network, a next generation television network building content on the digital platform in the information, news and infotainment space. He also anchors seasonal shows on Indian news television and writes for Forbes India and Business Standard. Previously, he was Founder-Editor in Chief of Bloomberg TV India. He has also worked with Business Standard newspaper as Editor (New Media) and with television channel CNBC-TV18. He is a Fellow of the Inaugural Class of Ananta Aspen India Leadership Initiative and trained in the Aspen style of moderating.



SUDHA IYER has two MS degrees in Molecular Biology and Genetics and a PhD in Health Education. After working for 13 years at The Johns Hopkins University and Sinai Hospital, she returned to India with a view to establish a strong group of companies that do both business and service in India. Sudha serves as the Chairperson and Managing Director of the Srijana Group, focussing on Web Business, Knowledge Services, Health Services, Storage Maximization and Family Services. She also heads the Haritas Health Services that focuses on delivering health education to people with diabetes and other chronic ailments. She conceptualised CII's Yi Bridge program and built the e-Yi platform. She is a Fellow of the Inaugural Class of Ananta Aspen India Leadership Initiative and trained in the Aspen style of moderating.
